JOB

DESCRIPTION: This is a full-time, non-exempt position working 40 hours per week, 187 days/year. The Residential Supervisor supervises and interacts with children during recreational times, meal times, and study times. Assists students with homework assignments; some tutoring may be involved. The Residential Supervisor is also responsible for the safety and security of the students.

MINIMUM

QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's Degree preferred; high school diploma required; individual must be of strong moral character, enthusiastic, and work well with children in recreational activities. The individual must be able to respond to a variety of situations including emergencies. Experience working with deaf children is helpful.

Sign language skills of applicants will be rated using the Sign Language Proficiency Interview (SLPI); "Intermediate" level skills are required at hire with "Advanced" skills required within two years of employment.

FBI, Child Abuse and Criminal Background clearances required.

SALARY: Dependent upon experience with full benefits including membership in the State's teacher retirement system, medical, dental and vision benefits, and life insurance.
