Responsibilities include planning, preparing, and presenting lessons to address individual student goals, using appropriate communication techniques to assure clarity and accuracy of conveyed information, working with the Academic Team in guiding parents toward identifying their child's strengths and weaknesses and in programming for them accordingly through the IEP process, attend in-service meetings and departmental meetings to participate in decision-making, maintaining current knowledge in the field, i.e., techniques and methodologies utilized in the provision of speech and language services in accordance with best practice, and maintenance of records of student progress, achievement, and discipline according to the needs of each assigned student.
