**MINIMUM**

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Bachelor's Degree with PA Dept of Education Certification in Speech and Language Impaired, and Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC) is required. Master's Degree with PDE certification in Speech and Language Impaired, dual certification in Hearing Impaired preferred. Experience working with deaf and hard of hearing children is also preferred.

This position will be rated using Sign Language Proficiency Interview (SLPI). The level for this position is "Advanced." The minimum level accepted at hire is "Novice Plus."
