**DESCRIPTION:** Responsibilities of the Principal includes the following:

 Regularly observes, evaluates, and advises teachers regarding educational techniques and procedures

- Supervises student discipline and serves as a resource to teachers in planning and implementing behavior management procedures
- Reviews student progress, makes recommendations, and develops reports regarding changes in curriculum, classes or program
- Meets and consults with parents, school districts, IUs, and/or other agencies in order to develop/provide appropriate programs for students (IEP, MDE, Child Study)
- Coordinates special departmental visitors, assemblies, and events including planning and supervising department in-service programs
- Serves as a liaison for teachers and students of the department with other offices and departments of the school
- Orders and maintains supply of materials, texts, and furnishings needed within the department
- Coordinates teacher's and teacher aides' schedules and assigns special responsibilities as necessary to ensure appropriate day-to-day operations in the department
